1. Introduction of Canton Fair

The China Import and Export Fair, also known as the Canton Fair, is an important and long-standing channel for China's foreign trade and a window for businesses from around the world to explore China's vast selection of manufactured goods and industrial solutions, and as such it plays a key role in advancing the development of China's foreign trade and the economic and trade exchanges between China and the rest of the world. It is thus renowned as "China's No. 1 Trade Fair".

The Canton Fair is co-hosted by the Ministry of Commerce of PRC and the People's Government of Guangdong Province and organized by China Foreign Trade Centre. It is held every spring and autumn in Guangzhou, China. Since its establishment in 1957, the Canton Fair has enjoyed the



longest history, the largest scale, the biggest buyer attendance, the most diverse buyer source countries, the most complete product variety, and the best business turnover in China for 134 sessions. The 134th Canton Fair (held in autumn of 2023) attracted overseas buyers from 229 countries and regions, including 129,006 who attended onsite and 390,574 online.

The attraction of the Canton Fair lies in both the quantity and diversity of products on display. When it comes to product manufacturing China is the world leader in many areas, with Chinese manufacturers offering highly flexible and customisable services, as well as quality guarantees and after-sales support. Chinese manufacturers are extremely willing to satisfy the requirements

of their customers, and more than happy to invite serious buyers to visit factories in person for peace of mind.

Due to the immense scale of the Canton Trade Fair, the Fair is split into three separate phases. Each phase aims to cover a certain grouping of related industries. The order and contents of each phase are laid out below:
